#### **Adoption of Agenda**

Moved by Mayor Granberg, seconded by Deputy Mayor Pike to adopt the agenda as presented, with the one item being the adoption of the revised 2023 budget and tax & fee structure 2023.

The floor was passed to Councillor Hillier-Smith.

We are holding this special meeting regarding the budget and taxes because we have to increase these amounts for 2023. The reason our taxes had to be increased this year is so our 2023 budget could be approved by the Department of Municipal and Provincial Affairs, who noted that as per the accountability measures for funding under the Municipal Operating Grant and Provincial Gas Tax Sharing programs include the requirement for Municipalities to maintain their own source revenues, on a per capita basis (as per the 2021 census), in their municipal budgets over own source revenue levels in their 2015 municipal budget.

Basically this means our total taxation amount for 2023 divided by the population in the last census of 2021 equals our per captia and this amount has to be more than the per captia amount in 2015. In 2015 the population was less than the population in the 2021 census therefore the tax rate of \$350.00 and the mil rate of 0.7 no longer meets the per captia amount needed. Therefore taxes had to be increased to \$380.00 and the mil rate to 0.75. These amounts are the minimum that Municipal Affairs would accept to meet our per capita requirements and accept our budget for 2023.

The following are the changes to the tax and fee structure for 2023. Property tax is now \$380.00 per property under assessment value of \$500,000.00 over this amount at a mil rate of 0.75. Property tax on businesses is now \$380.00 per property under assessment value of \$500,000.00 over this amount at a mil rate of 0.75 and home and tenant businesses is \$400.00 per year. All taxes are due by June 30, 2023. Interest will be charged on all overdue tax accounts at a rate of 4.5% which in 2022 it was 1.5% and is charged on interest and compounded interest, monthly. A copy of the tax and fee structure will be included with the property tax invoices.
