- Snow clearing contract The tender was awarded at our public meeting on December 1, 2023, so we now have a signed snow clearing contract up until April 10, 2024.

Grants update: The playground equipment has been installed and we were just waiting one piece of equipment that is here now and the company has been notified so the installers can come back and finish this in the spring now, so the Ralph Calloway Memorial Park playground will remain closed for the winter season. A big thanks to Deputy Mayor Pike for all the work she put into getting this project finished. It was a lot of prep work to get this project from start to finish. Maybe we will have a special opening for these new updates to our playgrounds.

Ralph Calloway Memorial Park, Park Liaison, Crown Lands - Mayor Granberg

- Sewer disposal tank update In the new year we will start to plan for the second stage in the sewer tank system and the road in that area.
- The playground at the Ralph Calloway Memorial Park playground will remain closed until new equipment piece is installed.
- There is a tree down near the emergency gate area. Mayor Granberg will check into getting it moved.
- Council will investigate the option of a tank for the calcium and water to be spread this season and the options for the sewer dumping for the campers.
- Crown lands update Two more approved by Crown Lands and just waiting for surveys
 and septic designs. Two applications have been placed on hold with Crown Lands
 because we now must get approval from the minister to apply for these land extensions

in which both ourselves and Crown Lands was unaware of in the past. This is as per section 201 of the Municipalities Act.
